Journey west to explore the Actun Tunichil Muknal ceremonial caves and a full day expeditions into the Chiquibul Forest Reserve and Mayan Ruins of Caracol. You will also have a chance to swim and explore the Rio Frio Caves and Rio On Pools. Over three nights we enjoy the intimate hospitality of the Tut family at their Crystal Paradise Resort near San Ignacio in the Cayo District.

Typical Daily Itinerary:

Day 1: Rendezvous with your driver in Dangriga, Belize City or the Belize International Airport, and transfer to SanIgnacio Town. From here, we follow a meandering road to Crystal Paradise Resort – in a picturesque setting andperched on a hill above the Macal River. You have time to settle in and explore.Accommodation: Crystal Paradise ResortMeals: Dinner

Day 2: After an early breakfast, the drive to Caracol takes us through breathtaking scenery through the Pineridge, over a series of creeks, and then descending into lush tropical rainforest. Caracol dates back to the classic period and is Belize's largest and most spectacular Mayan city. Believed to have defeated Tikal in war around 560 A.D., there are over 35,000 known buildings, 5 plazas, 4 palaces, 3 temples, 24 stelae, 2 ball courts, reservoirs, causeways, and an astronomical observatory. Today's activities also include a visit to the Rio Frio Caves and the Rio On Pools for a swim. **Accommodation: Crystal Paradise Resort**

Day 3: Today's extraordinary journey takes us deep underground and into the Mayan underworld known as Xilbalba, amythical realm inhabited by spirits, powerful gods and secretive rituals. We hike, wade, swim and climb our way intothe sacrificial chambers to witness first-hand artifacts, deep in the Actun Tunichil Muknal caves system.Accommodation: Crystal Paradise ResortMeals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Day 7: Birdlife and wildlife abound and early mornings are the most active. Wake to a coffee, grab your binoculars and spend a quiet hour watching wildlife. Your transfer time this morning will be set based on your next tour rendezvous or your international flight time.
