Bocawina Rainforest Resort: This unique eco-resort is located in the Southern Maya Mountains adjacent to the world-famous 100,000-acre Cockscomb Jaguar Reserve. Waterfalls cascading into crystal clear jungle pools, resplendent tropical birds, and wild cats roaming a 7000-acre National Park are part of the extraordinary setting for your next rainforest adventure. Nowhere else in Belize can you enjoy the comforts of a boutique eco-lodge, Belizean-style dining, and a limitless selection of adventures within a National Park.

The Colonial Inn at Jaguar Reef Resort: Set against a stunning beachfront in Hopkins Village. Explore the charm of Hopkins or venture out sea, and retreat to a room of luxurious hardwood furnishings, refreshing air conditioning, and plush comforts to call your own. Enjoy access to a full-service resort and spa at the adjoining Lodge at Jaguar Reef, and benefit from a beachfront restaurant, sun-soaked lounge chairs, swaying palms, and colorful Kayaks at your disposal.

Typical Daily Itinerary:

Day 1: You will be met in Dangriga and transported to your eco-resort in the Southern Maya Mountains. Once you arrive, you'll get a welcome drink, meet your fellow guests and then choose your guided activities for your next four days of adventure in the rainforest. We suggest you start with a night and be amazed by the rainforest creatures of the night!

Day 2-3: Rise with the sun and be on the grounds for the first light of day emerging through the jungle mists. Waking up to the sounds of the tropics is a pure delight, with the chatter of parrots and parakeets flying overhead, the fresh morning air scented with tropical blossoms, and the expectation of an exciting adventure-filled day ahead. There is no need to venture far to experience the heart of the jungle. Bocawina offers the longest zipline adventure in Belize, seven different waterfalls, unexcavated Mayan ruins, and a multitude of bird species and wildlife.

You can select from the many on-site activities offered by the resort: ziplining, hiking, rappelling, birdwatching, etc make sure you sign up at the front desk!

Day 4: Our last morning at Bocawina is completely flexible. You can stay close to the lodge or follow a trail to a favorite pool or waterfall. We can transfer you to Hopkins right after breakfast, or drop you off later in the day. The choice is yours! Upon arrival at Hopkins, settle into your room, then head out to the pool area for a refreshing beverage and dip. We have left your time at Hopkins totally flexible so you can be as relaxed or as active as you like. Lounge poolside, hop on a bicycle or sign up for an optional excursion at the hotel activity desk.

Itinerary Con't:

Meals can be enjoyed at the hotel, or you may want to check out some of the nearby restaurants and bars. Hopkins has an interesting mix of cultures and cooking styles. Day 5, 6: Spend the next two days relaxing by the pool, strolling along the beach, and discovering Hopkins Village and the surrounding area. Watch the local fisherman paddle out at sunrise in dug-out canoes to catch their fish for the day. Take a kayak out to see the sunset over Victoria's Peak, and view the rest of the mystic Maya Mountains as another day in paradise closes its eyes. Enjoy an evening of local Garifuna Drumming and sample some Belizean cuisine. Mingle with the friendly villagers, and experience Hopkins' rich Garifuna culture.
