Waterfalls cascading into crystal clear jungle pools, resplendent tropical birds, and wild cats roaming a 7000-acre National Park are part of the extraordinary setting for your next rainforest adventure. Nowhere else in Belize can you enjoy the comforts of a boutique eco-lodge, Belizean-style dining, and a limitless selection of adventures within a National Park.

Umaya Resort & Adventures: A beautiful resort in the Placencia peninsula, surrounded by a beautiful lagoon and the blue ocean. Experience the best of the island and mainland life. Laze on the shore, where the sand glitters with gold under the warm rays of sun, and the sea is a constant. The beachside is an oasis of relaxation, hosting both Fyah Bar & Grill and a vast swimming pool for hours of lazing in the cool blue water. Bike down to the village and get swept up in the dynamism and vitality of a place brimming with activity.

# **Typical Daily Itinerary:**

**Day 1:** You will be met in Dangriga and transported to your eco-resort in the Southern Maya Mountains. Once you arrive, you'll get a welcome drink, meet your fellow guests and then choose your guided activities for your next four days of adventure in the rainforest. We suggest you start with a night and be amazed by the rainforest creatures of the night!

**Day 2-3:** Rise with the sun and be on the grounds for the first light of day emerging through the jungle mists. Waking up to the sounds of the tropics is a pure delight, with the chatter of parrots and parakeets flying overhead, the fresh morning air scented with tropical blossoms, and the expectation of an exciting adventure-filled day ahead. There is no need to venture far to experience the heart of the jungle. Bocawina offers the longest zipline adventure in Belize, seven different waterfalls, unexcavated Mayan ruins, and a multitude of bird species and wildlife.

You can select from the many on-site activities offered by the resort: ziplining, hiking, rappelling, birdwatching, etc make sure you sign up at the front desk!

**Day 4:** Your last morning at Bocawina is completely flexible. You can stay close to the lodge or follow a trail to a favorite pool or waterfall. We can arrange your transfer to Placencia for after breakfast, or can drop you off later in the day if you want more rainforest time!

Upon arrival at your beach hotel, you may want to settle into your room before enjoying a refreshing drink by the beach bar. Later, why not take an exploratory walk along the uncrowded palm-lined beaches of the Peninsula?

## **Itinerary Con't:**

The Peninsula is only a mile at its widest and is positioned between the Placencia Lagoon on the west, and the Caribbean Sea on the east. It is possible to stroll north seven miles from Placencia Village to Seine Bight Village without interruption.

We have left your time at Placencia totally open....lounge poolside, hop on a bicycle or sign up for an optional excursion at the hotel activity desk. Meals can be enjoyed at your resort hotel, or you can sample some local cuisine in the nearby villages of Placencia and Seine Bight.

**Day 5, 6:** Spend the next two days discovering the Placencia Peninsula. Relax in a hammock with a good book, go beachcombing...or consider saltwater fly fishing or a sunset cruise. Check out Placencia Village and its myriad of shops, restaurants, and bars then head over to Seine Bight Village for some traditional Garifuna music.

**Day 7:** Enjoy an early morning swim, or take a bike ride through the village. This last day is yours to enjoy at your leisure before you fly home or continue on your travels.

Return transfer is provided to the local airport in Placencia to catch your connecting flight to Belize City.

#### **EXTRA NIGHT**

If you are adding an extra night in the rainforest, you will have the option to join an off-site tour on day 4th of your trip. From chocolate making to Mayan ruins, from cave exploration to horseback riding there are many tours available.
