Experience Belize from two unique perspectives: our Glover's Reef Adventure Basecamp on Southwest Caye and the vibrant over-the-water Cabanas at Tobacco Caye Paradise. These idyllic settings showcase the untouched beauty of Belize's most pristine coral reefs. Experience the authentic island culture of Belize in an area that remains unspoiled. No previous paddling experience required.

"**Basecamping**" involves sleeping in wall-tented cabanas. These spacious safari-style tents have ample headroom to walk around, are on raised wooden floors, and have real wood-framed beds (6-inch foam mattresses). Tents can be configured with either double or single beds. All bed linen is provided.

Typical Daily Itinerary:

Day 1: Upon arriving at the International Airport, connect for a scenic 20-minute flight to the coastal town of Dangriga and then by road to Bocawina Rainforest Resort in the foothills of the Maya Mountains. Tonight, we dine in the rainforest at the acclaimed Wild Fig restaurant.

Accommodation: Bocawina Rainforest Resort

Meals: Dinner

Day 2-4: After breakfast, we travel by boat 38 miles offshore of the mainland to Glovers Reef Atoll. We check into our furnished tent cabanas and enjoy lunch al fresco. Then, guides provide professional instruction - teaching sea kayaking, paddleboard, snorkeling, and safety in tropical seas- before heading out on the water.

We explore the Atoll by sea kayak and paddleboard with motorboat support. Our staff will pamper you with delicious food for the next three days. Enjoy perfect days of turquoise clear waters, coral reefs, and a full range of activities to choose from each day.

Accommodation: Glover's Reef Basecamp

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Day 5-6: We head to the 17,000-acre Southwater Caye Marine Reserve on the Southern Barrier Reef for our adventure's next stage. Tobacco Caye Paradise, a fairy-tale setting of palm trees, coral islands, mangrove forests, and abundant coral reefs, will be your playground for the next two days. We take in Belize's friendly, laid-back 'Island Culture' at this beautiful location. Each evening you can toast the sunset from your private beach cabana.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Day 7: In the morning, we return to the town of Dangriga, where our trip finishes in time to make domestic or international flight connections.

Travel Notes: Travellers leaving Belize after this trip (day 7) require a short domestic flight from Dangriga to Belize International Airport (BZE). International connections require a departure after 1:30 p.m.
