The **Belize Ultimate Adventure** is our most adventurous trip yet; it takes you off-grid and into the wilderness, far from the usual tourist path. Its varied itinerary explores Belize's vibrant cultures, tropical rainforests, wild rivers, and remote villages. The trip finishes with a journey 36 miles out to sea to a stunningly beautiful and pristine coral atoll. This trip is a perfect match for those looking for an active, adventurous vacation that encompasses the best that Belize offers.

"Basecamping" involves sleeping in wall-tented cabanas. These spacious safari-style tents have ample headroom to walk around, are on raised wooden floors, and have real wood-framed beds (6-inch foam mattresses). Tents can be configured with either double or single beds. All bed linen is provided.

Typical Daily Itinerary:

Day 1: Upon arrival at the International Airport, connect for a scenic 20-minute flight to the town of Dangriga and then travel overland to Bocawina Rainforest Resort in the foothills of the Maya Mountains. Tonight, we dine in the rainforest at the acclaimed Wild Fig restaurant.

Accommodation: Bocawina Rainforest Resort Meals: Dinner

Day 2: From Bocawina, we travel south into the Mayan homeland of Belize, an area of rich indigenous culture and stunning scenery. Your guides teach you the skills you need to confidently paddle your inflatable kayak in moving water before we start our journey down Belize's most beautiful rainforest rivers. Your guides will be there to cook and set up camp when the night falls, you are welcome to help out and learn new camping and cooking skills.

Accommodation: Jungle River Camp Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Day 3: Wake to a tropical rainforest setting in the Moho River Valley that feels straight out of a storybook. We break contact entirely with the outside world as we follow the Moho River through canyons and lush rainforests. Each bend reveals the river's dynamic nature, with calm, meandering sections and stretches of exciting rapids and chutes. Our evenings along the river include storytelling and night walks in the jungle.

Accommodation: Jungle River Camp Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Day 4: In the morning, as we descend out of the Maya Mountains, the river changes its nature, widens and begins to meander into the coastal plains. On route back to Bocawina, we stop for lunch at the ancient Mayan city of Lubaantun, a beautiful ridgetop site overlooking the Columbia River Valley. Settle into your room and pamper yourself with all the amenities of our boutique eco-lodge. We'll gather at the bar before enjoying dinner at the Wild Fig restaurant.

Accommodation: Bocawina Rainforest Resort Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Day 5: Even though we've changed from a riverside camp to a comfortable resort, we're still in the midst of the pristine rainforest. Today, we'll hike to hidden waterfalls with astounding views of the Caribbean Sea, and you can choose to rappel down a waterfall, one of the unique attractions of Bocawina. After lunch, a thrilling new adventure awaits a two-and-a-half-mile rainforest canopy zipline course—the longest in Belize!

Accommodation: Bocawina Rainforest Resort Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Day 6 to 9: After breakfast, we travel 36 miles offshore to our private Basecamp on Southwest Caye within Glover's Reef Marine Reserve. In this incomparable setting of turquoise waters and living coral reefs, we have four perfect days of paddling sea kayaks and SUPs, snorkeling, sailing, and fishing. Best of all, your Basecamp staff will ensure your stay is beyond exceptional, so expect to eat delicious meals and be pampered between your daily adventures.

Our itinerary will remain flexible over the next four days to accommodate individual and group preferences. Activities include paddling sea kayaks, snorkeling the inner and outer walls of the reef, stand-up paddleboarding, traditional Belizean handline fishing, and learning to sail a kayak. In the mornings and evenings, our guides share their knowledge of Belize, its unique marine environments, and the cultures of the Caribbean with a focus on the Garifuna people of Belize. There are many different activities you can choose from, and always, for those looking to add downtime to their adventure, there is no better place in Belize to kick back in a hammock and relax with a good book!

Day 10: Our boat charter departs the atoll mid-morning and returns to the town of Dangriga around noon (approximately). Our staff will help connect you to the next leg of your journey or the international airport. For travellers leaving Belize on this day, international connections must depart after 3:00 p.m.

Accommodation: None Meals: Breakfast

Travel Notes: Travellers leaving Belize after this trip (day 10) require a short domestic flight from Dangriga to Belize International Airport (BZE) on Sunday afternoon. Please ensure your international flight departs after 3:00 p.m.

The Ultimate Adventure is our most adventurous trip. Weather conditions can affect water levels and may increase the level of difficulty or require itinerary changes. The remoteness and variability of conditions are what make this trip the best of its kind in Belize.
